Re: Quarterly Report

Dear Andy and Governors:

Please find herein the quarterly report of the District Governor of 6C

As of July 29, the district has a census of 716 members down from 723, having lost 9 members and added 2. The district has 31 clubs with an additional club in the final stages of formation as this report is prepared. A new club, Denver Stapleton, was added in the final quarter of last year. Seven clubs have less than 10 members; 14 clubs have between 11 and 20 members; and 5 have between 21 and 30 members. There are only 5 clubs with more than 30 members. The district has 1 Leo Club of record.

The district has 3 clubs who have not yet reported officers elected. Only 4 clubs have reported activities for July and only 18 have filed membership for July.

District 6C is currently finalizing a membership development plan and is concurrently working with the leadership team of 6SE to complete due diligence for consideration of district consolidation. This is the final step of a multi-year study and plan and the process is being facilitated by PCC Bob Selle.

Goals for 2016-2017

Goal 1 Increase membership by 100 in 1st quarter

- Objectives:
1. Increase net membership by a net of 100 including replacing deceased members and members who move.
 2. Review and revise membership development plan monthly.
 3. Add three new clubs by January 1, 2017.

- Strategies:
1. Use "Each One, Ask One" program. Each current club needs only 1 new member by October 31 as coordinated by GMT leader with Each One Ask One initiated August 21, 2017.
 2. Three Clubs account for 75 new members.
 3. Promote family membership.

Goal 2 Initiate Club assessment and community needs process

- Objective:
1. Priority clubs are those with less than 20 members (21 clubs)
 - a. Double priority club membership in 60 days
 - b. Assess current Club and potential new club in same area.
 2. Assess community needs in areas of Anschutz campus, Lutheran Hospital and Swedish Hospital with intention of new Standard Club or Specialty Club

- Strategies:
1. Zone Chairs and VDG become deeply involved in Priority clubs (initiate in 30 days)
 2. Recruit Guiding Lions to become involved with each Priority Club. (within 30 days) GLT leader and VDGs will coordinate.
 3. Train additional Guiding Lions as necessary. GLT leader responsibility
 4. Initiate Community Needs Assessment by GMTeam. Coordinated by team leader.

GOAL 3 (As the Governors are well aware, potential goals are limitless and unending. This goal is a continuing and continuous and does not have a due date. It is a goal for myself and hopefully for ensuing Governors) **Create and maintain a goal driven culture for 6C.**
