



Colorado Lions KidSight Program Report Lions MD 6 Council Meeting January 21, 2017

KidSight Screening – Screening is well underway for the 2016-2017 school year. 41,274 children have been screened and 4,555 children referred, an 11.3% rate of referral. Screening is ongoing and our screening numbers are well ahead of last year in all districts.

Grants and Funds Received – KidSight Colorado participated again in Colorado Gives Day which was December 6, 2016. We set a goal to raise \$6,500. We did not meet the goal however we raised more than \$4100. We have received grants from the Anschutz Family Foundation, CoBiz Cares Foundation and the O'Rourke Foundation since the last Council meeting. Grants are currently pending from the Christian Foundation, Delta Gamma Foundation and the Schlessman Family Foundation.

KidSight USA – The KidSight USA database committee has begun work on the new database which will collect screening data nationwide. The focus is on developing a site that is easy to use so that we can obtain as much data on vision screening as possible. This will be the first database which will collect national data on vision screening in the country. Since we have a statewide program KidSight Colorado will be responsible for all data entry into the database. This will allow for consistent and accurate reporting for Colorado. Districts and clubs will not have to do any data entry into the system.
