RE: Council Report

Our LCIF year is half over. The figures from July 1, 2016 until December 31, 2016 are in. On behalf of your foundation, I would like to say thank you to our District Governor's, our District and Club LCIF Chairpersons, and all the Lions of MD-6 for your donations to LCIF, our help to our Multiple District 6 Lions programs as well as our work and prayers worldwide during the numerous natural disasters we have had these past months.

Please keep in mind that this 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration also includes LCIF, and especially in completing our goal of having every club in Multiple District 6 showing a donation to our Foundation. Currently as a Multiple we are struggling to get our clubs to help fulfill our goal. We are currently at 33.58 percent of all clubs showing a donation. District 6-W leads with 50% of their clubs showing a donation, and two 100% Contributing Member Clubs. District 6-C is next with 45.16% and one 100% Contributing Member Club, NE has only 2.73% and SE with 20.69% of the clubs showing support.

This look changes when we look at donation amounts. NE leads the category with \$10,645 in Donations. Central with \$4,516, 6-W with \$4,365 and SE with \$1365. Our MD-6 totals for the first half of our Lions Anniversary year total \$22,785.

Districts, please continue to work toward our 100% goal. If you need further help or information, Please feel free to contact your District LCIF Coordinator, or feel free to contact me.
