Md-6 Council Report
October 22, 2016

Lions of MD-6:

Let's quickly review the goals for our Multiple District 6 for the Centennial Year 2016-2017. This brings me to the goals we have for LCIF for this Centennial Year.

- 1.) All District Governor Teams support LCIF with personal donations, (at least the \$20.00 Contributing Member Program level) and include LCIF in any of their presentations. This would include your Zone Chairs, and other cabinet chairs.
- 2.) District Coordinators (PDG Gwen Balk 6-C, PID Tom Toliver 6-NE, PCC Bob Selle 6-SE and PDG Walter Lemon 6-W) make an effort to contact each Club within their District and discuss the Contributing Member and Melvin Jones Fellow programs,
- 3.) As it is the Centennial Year, we hope to get 100% of our 134 Clubs to donate to our Foundation.

We are now through the first quarter of the year, and results are in for our Lions of MD 6. Lion of District 6 NE have made donations in the amount of \$4,930.00. (However over \$4,000.00 of this amount has come from one club.) District 6-C made donations in the amount of \$1,670.00, SE has donated \$750.00 and District 6-W has donations in the amount of \$3,660.00 with 3 100% LCIF banner clubs, meaning they show a donation from each member in these clubs.) The total for donations is \$11,205.00 for the first quarter. This is better than we had last year, and we applaud the Lions of Colorado for their support.

MD-6 currently shows 23.13% of the 134 Clubs in the Multiple have donated to their Foundation. We do hope this percentage grows to 100% by June 30, 2017 to fulfill our goals. We urge the District Governors, Vice District Governors, LCIF Coordinators, Zone Chairpersons and other leaders to get the message to their clubs. As we were there 100 years ago at the beginning of Lions Clubs International, let's show that we are still one of the best with our support of our Foundation.

LCI has made a change to the PU-101 form for officers. There is now a mandatory Chairperson area for the LCIF Club Coordinator. This means they are requesting each club to designate a coordinator for their Club, who will receive and distribute information from LCIF.

Just remember that LCIF is Your Foundation. Please support Your Foundation as they rush toward their 50 year anniversary in 2018!!
