Goal :

Action plan:

Committee Chairs or DG's will click on links on LCI website

Order peace poster kits

Print out district peace poster chairpersons guide

Print out entry form(one for each contestant)

Print out Lions International peace post contest rules

Goal: Obtain winning peace poster from each Committee Chairs or DG's

Action Plan:

Collect winning poster from each district after being judged at the district level from 6C, 6SE,6NE and 6W

Each district should have a 1st,2nd and 3rd place winner if possible(with the 1st place winner going to State to see who the State winner will be.)

Have the 4 district winners judged by independent judges

Send state winner to Lions International(Recognize State winner at State Convention in May 2017)

LCI will determine who the International Peace Poster Contest winner will be.
